

# Minor in Creative Writing

The Writing Arts Department at Rowan University offers a program of study in creative writing leading to a minor. To fulfill the requirements for the minor, students must complete 18 hours of course work selected from a variety of courses in the writing of poetry, fiction, children's stories, plays, television, and film scenarios. The minor is open to Writing Arts majors and students who are not Writing Arts majors. Writing Arts majors who complete the 12-credit creative writing *concentration* within the major may take an additional 6 credits to receive the minor. No required courses counting toward the Writing Arts major can be double counted for the Creative Writing Minor.
